Welcome

For your information, here are some helpful notes about how we like to run our cattery so your cat can have a safe and happy stay.

Reservations

Please phone the clinic on 546 9646 or 'pop in' to make a booking for your cat. Inspection is welcome. Vaccinations are vital in preventing the spread of disease; so please ensure your cat is up-to-date with these. We require annual vaccination for all cats in the cattery and will need to see their vaccination certificate.

Arrival and Departure

Arrival and departure can be at anytime during Clinic opening hours, which are:

8am – 6pm Monday to Friday

8.30am – 12pm Saturday morning

It is possible to collect your cat at a pre-arranged time over the weekend.

Accommodation Charges

We have a few different types of cages and rates vary depending on the cage type and if you have one or two cats sharing the cage. We have special reductions available for long-term guests, with rates reducing after 10days and after 30 days. These charges are on a daily basis. Cats collected before 12noon on the day of departure will not be charged for that day. Please note surcharge rates applicable on Statutory Holidays.

Facilities

Our cages are spacious, clean, bright and warm. Each cage has a heated pad, toys and a scratching post, for your cat's leisure. We have a large 'Family Suite' available for an easygoing family of 3 cats or the single cat who likes a bit of extra room.

Food

All cats (unless otherwise requested) will be fed on one of the premium cat foods we stock in the clinic. If you (or your cat) prefer you may supply your cat's own food. If your cat is on a special diet i.e. prescription food, you will need to supply this. Price will not be reduced if own food is supplied.

Services

Peace of mind. Your cat is under veterinary supervised care so you can enjoy a worry free break.

Health Care. At your request, Staff are happy to de-worm (even the most difficult cat), flea treat, nail clip and groom your cat during it's stay.

Special Needs. The 'fussy eater', cats on medication, etc are all easily catered for.
